Staff Development

Professional Growth and Development for Non-administrative Staff

Additional training and study are prerequisites for continued growth and effectiveness of staff members. It is also necessary for staff members with increased responsibilities and new demands. Staff are encouraged to gain additional job-related skills through special study or in-service training.

The District will provide an orientation for all new staff.

Teachers who are new to the District will be provided an induction program to ensure they are familiar with District initiatives.

The District will provide staff with ongoing professional development to support continuous improvement.

Professional Growth and Development for Administrators

The Board recognizes that training and study for administrators contribute to their skill development necessary to better serve the needs of the District. Each year the Superintendent or designee will develop an administrative in-service program based upon the needs of the district, as well as the needs of individual administrators.

Tuition Reimbursement for Non-Represented Administrators

The West Valley School District Board of Directors supports professional development for nonrepresented administrators. Up to \$1,500 reimbursement for tuition-based professional development may be included in annual contracts for non-represented administrators. On or before September 1st of each year, the Superintendent will present to the Board for their review a list of administrators eligible for the reimbursement. This annual reimbursement limit will be reviewed by the Board periodically to ensure consistency with represented administrators (principals) in the District. Tuitionbased professional development may include subscriptions to professional journals, in-service, professional certificate expenses, and professional conference expenses held outside the district subject to the approval of the Superintendent.
