











Real life tips from West Valley parents

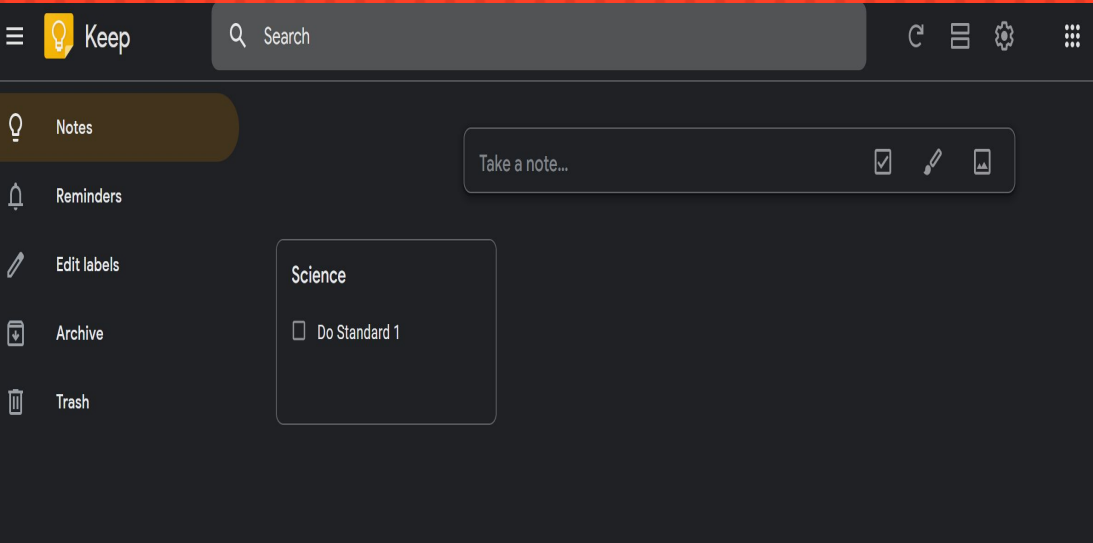

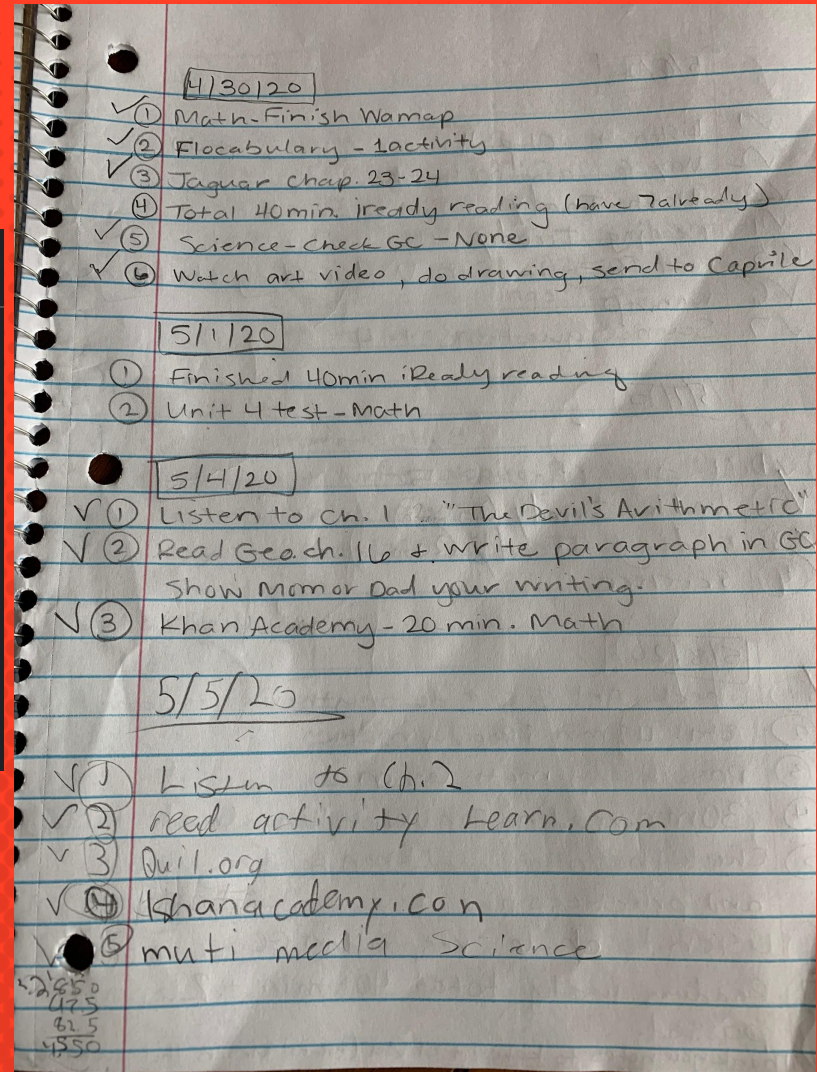

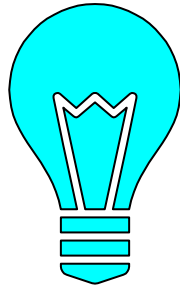
